Impact of COVID-19 at Veteran's Park Community Center

Update to Members

CABOT, Arkansas. (March 20, 2020) – On Thursday, March 19, 2020, the Governor of the State of Arkansas mandated that all gym (fitness style clubs) close to help prevent the spread of Covid-19. Below is the statement from the Arkansas Department of Health.

GYMS AND INDOOR ENTERTAINMENT VENUES Closed Due to the close contact that occurs among customers and staff and recent recommendations of avoiding social gatherings of more than ten (10) people, gyms (including fitness centers/clubs, fitness classes, and group fitness studios) and indoor entertainment venues, such as bowling alleys, trampoline parks, and indoor amusement centers, are closed to nonessential functions until further notice.

As of today, all auto drafts have been suspended. Members who have previously paid will be credited during this closure. For instance, if we are closed for two weeks, then two weeks will be added once we reopen to the public. Should you have any questions please contact the community center at 501.605.1506, Monday thru Friday from 8am to 5pm.

The CDC recommends that individuals avoid close contact with sick individuals, wash their hands frequently, avoid touching their eyes, nose and mouth, and use a disposable tissue for coughing or sneezing. In addition, any members or staff who are feeling ill or showing symptoms of the virus should stay home and contact a healthcare provider.

As this situation progresses, the Cabot Parks and Recreation Commission will continue to evaluate upcoming events, programs and policies and will share the information with the public on www.cabotparks.com as well as its social media pages. These adjustments are not due to panic, but to be cautious to our members and employees as safe as possible.
