Impact of COVID-19 at Veterans Park Community Center

Effective May 4, 2020

CABOT, Arkansas. (May 3, 2020) – The Cabot Parks and Recreation Department and Commission will make adjustments to the daily operations during Phase 1 of the opening of the Veterans Park Community Center on Monday, May 4th. The Cabot Parks and Recreation Commission in compliance with Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the Arkansas Department of Health (ADH), in an attempt to reduce exposure and mitigate the spread of COVID-19, the following will take place:

- The Community Center will be open for activities during the hours of:
 - (Monday-Friday 5am-7pm, Saturday, 8am-2pm and Sunday 12pm-6pm)
- Facility open to members only.
- Members under the age of 18 must be accompanied by their legal guardian who has a current membership. No new memberships will be sold.
- All members must wear masks. (except when actively exercising)
- Members must maintain 12ft social distance.
- No fitness classes.
- Lap/therapy pools and showers will be prohibited for use.
- Pick-up style basketball, racquetball, pickleball is prohibited at this time. Individual shooting will be allowed. Please bring your own basketball.
- No childcare will be available.
- All patrons must wash their hands before and after their visit.

The Cabot Parks and Recreation Commission will continue to follow all health and safety protocols currently in place as well as maintain focus on cleaning high traffic, commonly handled surfaces at the community center.

The CDC recommends that individuals avoid close contact with sick individuals, wash their hands frequently, avoid touching their eyes, nose and mouth, and use a disposable tissue for coughing or sneezing. In addition, any members or staff who are feeling ill or showing symptoms of the virus should stay home and contact a healthcare provider.

As this situation progresses, the Cabot Parks and Recreation Commission will continue to evaluate upcoming events, programs and policies and will share the information with the public on www.cabotparks.com as well as its social media pages. These adjustments are not due to panic, but to be cautious to our members and employees as safe as possible.
